- *Improved adoption rates! (In fact, 18 cats were adopted between the grand opening in October to the end of December 2015.)*

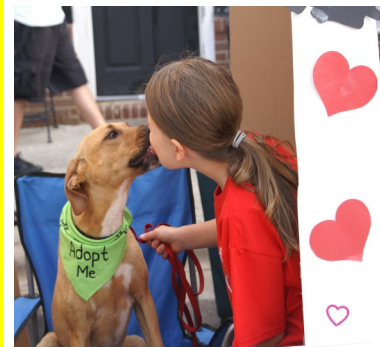
APS participates in Adopt-a-Thon

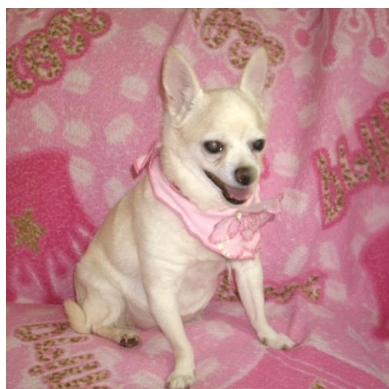

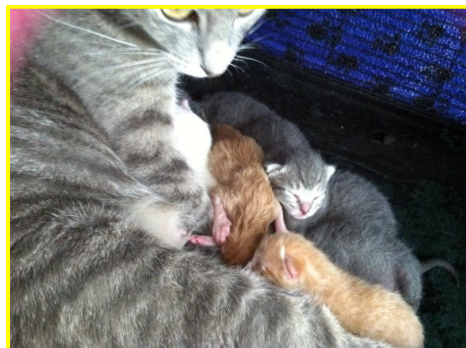

Momma Cat Takes Care of Her Own Kittens Plus 4 Orphans

APS rescued a beautiful momma cat and her 2 eight-week-old kittens in July from Person County Animal Services. The kittens, Misty & Felix, were quickly adopted with the help of PetSense, but Gretchen, the momma cat, was already carrying another litter of 4. The new kittens arrived on July 25.



Gretchen's story didn't end there. Only four days after the kittens were born APS received a heartbreaking call about 3 newborn kittens orphaned on the side of the road (after their momma was hit by a car). The 3 kittens were rescued and delivered to APS. It was our hope that Gretchen would willingly take in the 3 babies (with their eyes still closed) as if they were her own.

Gretchen didn't disappoint! The 3 kittens, plus another orphan found later, joined in on the love and feeding without hesitation! Gretchen has been promised that this is her LAST litter and that APS will find wonderful homes for her and her babies—all of them!
