## Fall Safety Tips for Your Pets

**Can other see your pet at night:** Daylight Savings Time means shorter days and longer nights - consider a reflective collar and/or leash.

**Monitor any health changes:** The change in season can bring on skin conditions and allergies. If you notice changes, contact your vet!

**Keep school supplies away from pets:** Pets and schools supplies are not a good combo. Keep glue sticks, pencils, magic markers, and crayons out of reach!

### Halloween Safety:

Halloween is another holiday when many pets go missing. Kid's costumes may frighten your pet **AND** there's a lot of opportunities to run out the door as Trick or Treaters visit. Put your pet in a safe place during Halloween activities!



**Fleas and ticks - ick:** Fleas and ticks are still prevalent during the fall season. Check your pet when they come inside & continue prevention.

**Be cautious about rodent poisons:** The use of rat & mouse poisons increase during the fall season as rodents seek shelter from the cooler temps. These poisons are highly toxic to your pets, as well.
